Minutes of Abingdon LTC Annual General Meeting Thursday 26 February 2009

We were joined beforehand by the two Community Support Police Officers Chris and Emma who are designated CSPOs for South Abingdon. They have been patrolling the area on their bikes for a year. Chris reminded all members to ring 999 in an emergency or any life threatening situation requiring immediate action. However any suspicious activity in the Car park, or around the courts should be reported on 08458 505 505. There has been cocaine/marijuana activity in the car park, but Abingdon is the safest area in the Thames Valley.

There has been a Crime Report prepared by the Crime Reduction officer Roger Foster. This recommends lighting in the Car Park. The Police will work with the Vale of White Horse District Council on this. However CCCTV would cost in the region of £17,000 and this outlay would only be possible if the Rugby, Football and Tennis Clubs worked with the VWHDC to raise the money.
